

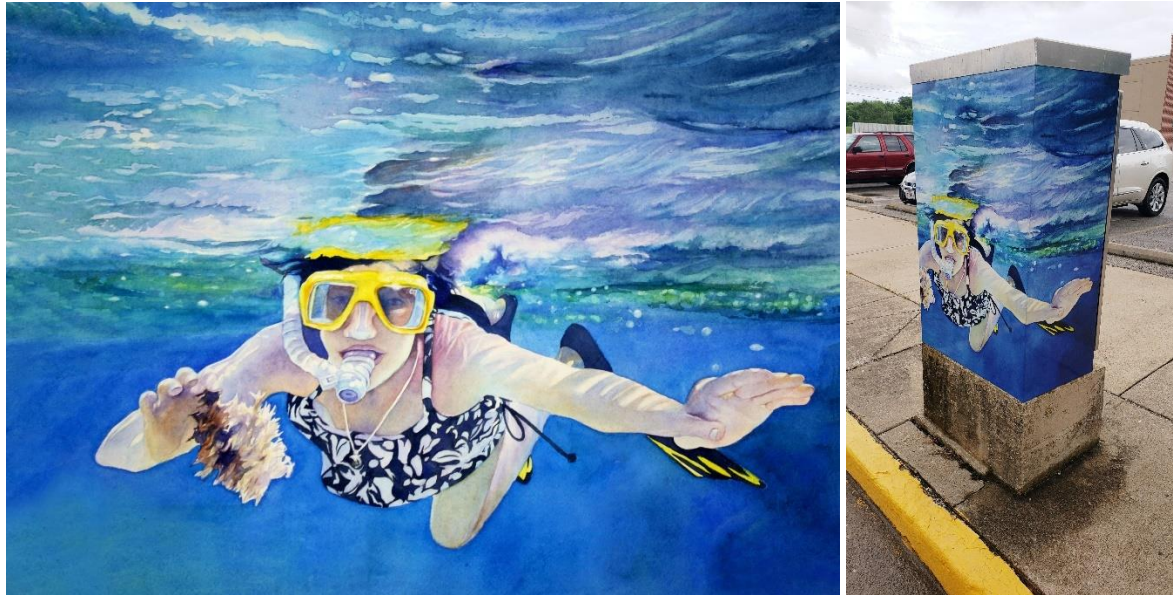
ART: OUT OF THE BOX

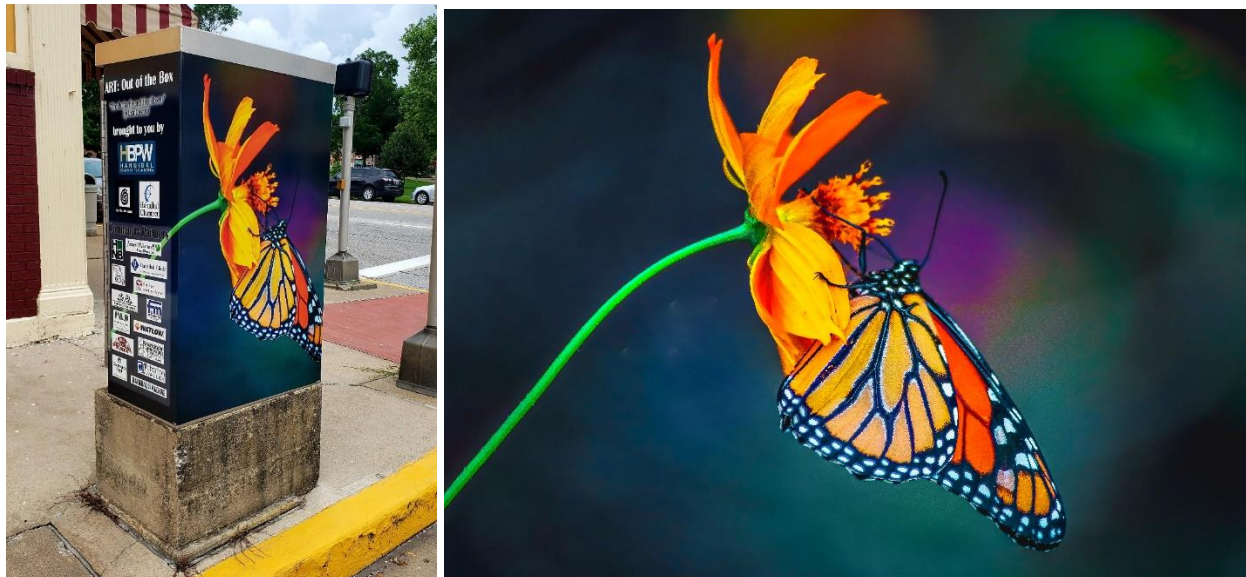

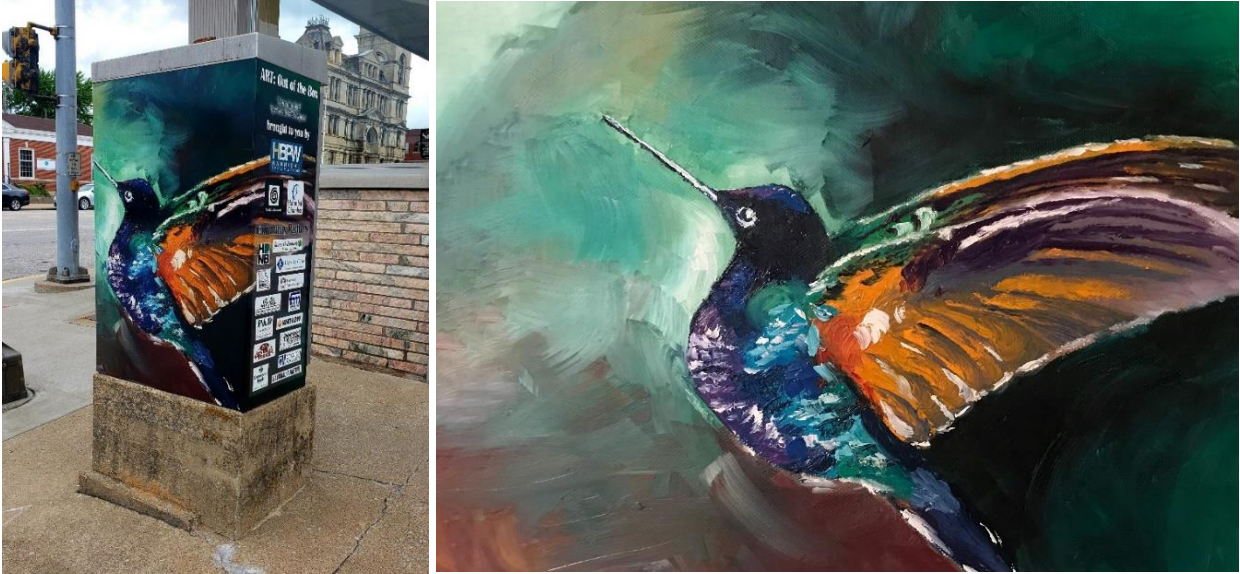
