REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY

- 1. In an effort to uphold our Statement of Purpose, the Hannibal Folklife Festival is open to theme-appropriate exhibitors, including traditional craftsmen, artisans, artists and makers.
- 2. We encourage exhibitors to demonstrate some phase of their art form during the festival.
- 3. Accepted exhibitors are expected to adhere to themeappropriate products, dress and booth presentation.
- 4. All work must be original executions by the applicant. No buy/sell, kits, machine-made or commercial mold items are allowed.
- 5. Exhibitors will be selected by a jury committee. Not all applicants are accepted.
- 6. Only items specifically accepted by the jury committee may be sold.
- 7. Booth spaces may not be shared unless work is collaborative.
