#### Statement of Purpose

The Hannibal Folklife Festival was created to educate and celebrate Hannibal's rich history by showcasing traditional craftsman, artisans, artists, makers, food, music and performers in the period setting and architecture of Hannibal's Historic North Main Street.

#### Requirement for Eligibility

- 1. In an effort to uphold our Statement of Purpose, the Hannibal Folklife Festival is open to theme-appropriate exhibitors – traditional craftsmen, artisans, artists and makers.
- 2. We encourage exhibitors to demonstrate some phase of their art form during the festival.
- 3. Accepted exhibitors are expected to adhere to theme-appropriate products, dress and booth presentation.
- 4. All work must be original executions by the applicant. No buy/sell, kits, machine-made or commercial mold items are allowed.
- 5. Exhibitors will be selected by a jury committee. Not all applicants are accepted.
- 6. Only items specifically accepted by the jury committee may be sold.
- 7. Booth spaces may not be shared unless work is collaborative.

### **Exhibitor Spaces**

Spaces are approximately 10' x 16' in an outdoor street festival setting. Display furnishings and booth atmosphere (i.e. signage, table coverings, chairs, etc) should be in keeping with the festival's Statement of Purpose. The use of electricity is discouraged.


